ABOUT NIT PUDUCHERRY:

National Institute of Technology Puducherry (NITPY), Karaikal, is an autonomous public engineering institute, declared as an Institute of National Importance by Government of India under NIT Act, 2007. The institute was established in 2010, and nestled in the scenes of Karaikal, a coastal enclave in the basin of river Kaveri in the Union Territory of Puducherry. NIT Puducherry is having a campus spread around 258 acres in the villages Poovam and Thiruvettakudy of Karaikal. societal background in a vibrant campus life. On the other hand, the mentoring process will shape the student for lifelong endeavors in academic, career, and personal life. For the latter, skills set like Human values, Work-life balance, techniques of counseling the student with reference to present lifestyle; effective mentoring in the presence and on virtual mode is very much required. This FDP will enable the faculty to revisit.
