### Circular

As per the decision of the administration, the Practical Classes and Assessments for both theory & Practical courses for the III-year B.Tech. Students will be conducted in the campus from 12.03.2021 to 08.05.2021. Therefore, the students are informed to report to the institute on or before 12.03.2021.

While reporting to the institute, the students are informed to follow the instructions of the Health Centre of the institute which are given below.

#### **For Hostel Residents:**

1. Students who are already in Treatment/ Self quarantine/ Community quarantine/ Institutional quarantine / Containment zone/ Hotspots area and who are having symptoms of Covid-19 will not be allowed to enter the institute campus.
2. Students are informed to have Covid-19 RT-PCR (Negative) test report and test should be obtained within 96 hours prior to their time of reporting to the Institute. **Students should bring hardcopy of negative Covid-19 RT-PCR report with the seal and signature of Doctor/Microbiologist from ICMR approved laboratory. No student will be permitted to enter the campus without Covid-19 RT-PCR (Negative) test report.**
3. Students are informed to report at the main gate with their ID card and have to undergo thermal screening and submit self -reporting form (provided at the main gate) and Covid-19 RT-PCR (Negative) Certificate. No accompanying person will be permitted to enter the campus as a preventive measure for covid-19.
4. Student should wear Three layered mask/cloth mask while entering the campus.
5. Student should undergo quarantine as per the advice of institute medical team.
6. During quarantine period students are instructed to stay in the allocated rooms.
7. Student will not be permitted to visit any other place before completing the quarantine period.
8. Students are permitted to attend their classes only after completion of quarantine period with Covid-19 Free/Asymptomatic certificate issued by institute medical officer.
9. Your reporting to the Institute should be informed to the respective Faculty advisor/HOD through e-mail.
10. Students who are staying in the hostel will not be permitted to go outside the campus. In case of emergency, they can leave the campus with prior approval from the concerned authority, strictly following the instructions from the medical Centre, after submitting travel intimation Form-I, on returning with the submission of travel intimation Form-II. They have to again undergo the quarantine process as instructed by the medical Centre.
11. Students are advised to bring sufficient quantity of face mask, hand sanitizer and other safety provisions.



**For day scholars:**

1. Day Scholars are informed to report to the campus on **29.03.2021**.
2. Students who are already in Treatment/Self quarantine/Community quarantine/Institutional quarantine / Containment zone/Hotspots area and who are having symptoms of Covid-19 will not be allowed to enter the institute campus.
3. Students are informed to have Covid-19 RT-PCR (Negative) certificate and test should be obtained within 48 hours prior to their time of reporting to the Institute. **Students should bring hardcopy of negative Covid-19 RT-PCR report with the seal and signature of Doctor/Microbiologist from ICMR approved laboratory. No student will be permitted to enter the campus without Covid-19 RT-PCR (Negative) test report.**
4. Students are informed to report at the main gate with their ID card and have to undergo thermal screening.
5. Student should wear Three layered mask/cloth mask while entering the campus. Otherwise they will not be permitted to the campus.
6. Students are informed to report directly to the Institute Health Centre first and submit self - reporting form (provided at health centre) and Covid-19 RT-PCR (negative) certificate. No accompanying person will be permitted to enter the campus as a preventive measure for Covid-19.
7. After medical screening you will get Covid19 Free/Asymptomatic certificate. Submit the certificate to your HOD and then you can join the classes.
8. As the day's scholar students are moving in and out of the campus you will be undergo medical screening & Covid-19 test at random, for which you should co-operate with the medical team.
9. Students are advised to refrain from attending classes if anyone of you or your family members show symptoms of Covid-19 and report to the institute health centre at the earliest.
10. Non-essential travels should be avoided.
